

The German Judo Federation (DJB) is the umbrella organization for judo in Germany. It comprises 18 regional associations and approximately 2,150 clubs with 127,000 judoka. The federation is a member of the German Olympic Sports Confederation (DOSB), the European Judo Union (EJU), and the International Judo Federation (IJF).

In this role, you will be responsible for the development of the national youth squad in the U21 or U18 categories (men and/or women). The location of employment will be part of the negotiations.

Your tasks:

- Annual planning for the respective age group in coordination with the Board of Performance Sport and according to the DJB's framework training concept.
- Planning, preparation, and execution of measures for the respective age group (daily training, competitions, and seminars).
- Nominating athletes for the national squad and its measures in coordination with the Board of Performance Sport.
- Methodical and pedagogical guidance of squad athletes in training, as well as at seminars and competitions, including preparation and follow-up.
- Training planning, documentation, control, and analysis of training progress of the athletes.
- Collaboration with national, base, state, and home coaches.
- Contribution to the DJB framework training concept as well as other DJB measures and concepts.
- Taking on necessary organizational and administrative tasks.
- Management in the area of talent identification and youth development.

We expect:

- Degree as a Diplom Trainer from the DOSB Trainer Academy (or comparable qualification) -> Minimum: Trainer A.
- Completion of the IJF Academy Level 1 Undergraduate Certificate as Judo Instructor (or to be completed as soon as possible).
- Experience in independent work as a coach in youth performance sports.

- Knowledge of common MS Office programs.
- A high degree of initiative, flexibility, and a healthy amount of assertiveness and decisiveness.
- Good English skills in spoken and written form.
- Willingness to work on weekends and travel for work.
