- Working with federal support center managers and Olympic support centers
- Contributing to the DJB's framework training concept and other DJB measures and concepts
- Participating in committees within the federation and higher-level organizations
- Assisting in the training and further education of coaches
- Taking on necessary organizational and administrative tasks
- Representing the German Judo Federation at given events in consultation with the board

- A diploma as a coach from the DOSB Trainer Academy (or an equivalent qualification)
- Completion of the IJF Academy Level 1 Undergraduate Certificate as a Judo Instructor (or the ability to complete it as soon as possible)
- Experience working independently as a coach in high-performance sports

- Proficiency in MS Office programs
- A high level of initiative, flexibility, and a healthy degree of assertiveness and decisiveness
- Good command of English, both spoken and written
- Willingness to work on weekends and undertake business trips
